Made In Detroit Scholarship

The CFPCA Made In Detroit Scholarship is established

- to recognize scholastic achievement,
- to encourage continued progress and
- to provide assistance to students in financing their education in the Department of Music.

Eligibility:

1. All currently enrolled full-time or part-time undergraduate and graduate students are eligible. However, students majoring in music will be given preference.
2. Recipients must be residents of the state of Michigan.
3. A minimum GPA is not required.
4. Applicants must include Pipeline printout showing current financial need.

Application Procedure:

Submit a letter in which you include:

- a. your major
- b. your student ID (nine digit number)
- c. your WSU email and current mailing address
- d. your financial aid statement (available through Pipeline)
- e. your WSU transcript (available through Pipeline)
- f. a statement describing your financial need, your estimation of what you have already achieved in your scholarly work as a student, what you hope to achieve by graduation and an outline of your reasons for requesting this award.

Funding Available: Two grants per year – one for the fall and one for the winter semester – will be awarded in the range of \$500 each. Grants will be disbursed through the Office of Student Financial Aid.

Deadline: February 1. Letters of request will be reviewed in the Dean's Office and decisions will be announced approximately ten days after the deadline.
